

Fish Regulations & Limits

John Takata, Waterfall Head Guide, highlights a few of the new 2010 regulations and some reminders. John, Steve Cockrell and Scott McKelvey are available for any questions.

As always, please remember to give your 2010 state of Alaska fishing license to your guide at the **beginning** of your trip. Your guide is required by state law to fill in your daily fishing data as each guest takes their limit. You cannot fish without your Alaska fishing license on board the boat.

There are several **new 2010 fish limit regulations** that include date parameters that are listed in the following table. Your guide will have a daily and trip limit guideline available for review on the boat.
